

WHY TIAKI TANGATA REINTEGRATION SERVICE?

The Tiaki Tangata reintegration service is a service designed to support Māori Tāne back into the community following a term of imprisonment.

We provide the referral access to a range of services based on identified needs focused on accommodation, employment, whānau and community. Clients are mentored to up to 12 months post release.

Tiaki Tangata will assist with accommodation needs within the Central North Island. This may be in the form of whānau support, transitional housing where available with known providers, or Tiaki Tangata housing.

We aim to support Māori Offenders who are serving a custodial sentence who are work ready.



TRANSITIONAL HOUSING

Our Tiaki Tangata Service has a support house in Rotorua and Tokoroa that accommodates up to three men living in a flatting type situation. They are drug and alcohoi free with a curfew. Residents also engage in weekly house meetings designed to support successful reintegration.

REFERRALS TO SERVICE

We service Tongariro, Waikeria and Springhill Prisons and Rotorua, Taupō, Tokoroa, Whakatāne and Hamilton Community Probation Service Centre's.

We also accept referrals from outside of this region on the basis that the Central North Island region is the preferred release destination. Inmates with Pacific Island ethnicity will be considered.
